Consider a Named Endowment Fund.

A Named Endowment Fund is an easy gift to create and understand.

- A Named Endowment is created and named in honor of a parent, loved one, or a family.
- Each year this fund, bearing the name of your loved one, would produce a certain dollar amount from the principal* to further the work of your parish or a charity close to your heart (or that of your honoree). You can designate the yearly gift to pay for a scholarship to a Catholic school, for Easter flowers, for Communion hosts/wine, for PSR textbooks, for Bibles for newly married couples, etc. You may also choose to have the annual gift be unrestricted for the needs of the parish at the time.
- Such a fund carries the honoree's name far into the future as it benefits a worthy cause and forever links their name with the charitable work performed.

** A Named Endowment Fund typically begins to generate gifts of interest when the principal reaches at least \$10,000. Some endowments are fully funded when they are created, others are funded by families over time. For example, one family established a fund honoring their parents, and the children made donations to it as birthday, holiday, and anniversary gifts. When the fund reached the \$10,000 mark, distributions to the charity/parish began.*
